<b>Sample</b>	All 265 state and officially recognised member universities of the German Rectors' Conference were contacted in February 2016 with a request for support. 153 of these universities agreed to participate. The universities were informed of a fixed quorum of randomly selected students to be invited, graded according to the size of the universities, measured by their number of students. Against the background of the targeted number of cases and the difficulties in reaching the target group, however, this should not fall below 5,000 students if possible, which meant a full survey at universities with a lower number of students.
