Notes

- r: Variable is not usable in CUF and download SUF, but in remote desktop SUF and on-site SUF.
- o: Variable is not usable in CUF, download SUF, and remote desktop SUF, but in on-site SUF.
- a: Variable cannot be used via any access path. However, it is documented because there are related questions in the questionnaire.
